Dear **Laura** - just an update that the monthly website hosting & maintenance fee for the Council website will be subject to a modest increase to £34.95 / month from the July billing cycle on the 1st of that month.

No company wants to pass on additional, albeit modest, costs to their clients - but we have not made any increase in our fees since April 2022.

You will understand that our own overheads - including server related & associated software, office and banking charges have continued to increase well above the annual inflation rate over that period.

As a reminder, this preferential fee represents excellent value covering as it does the weekly updates to the core files that make up the Wordpress based file system of the site, secure backups, general maintenance and last but not least our digital support & advice on all things "web related" as and when required.

In addition, we include a regularly updated SSL certificate which is required for all (and especially council) websites - otherwise visitors will get a "not secure" message. The fee also covers the licence fees which, as developers, we can negotiate at better rates for the software associated with all the digital forms on your site and other services required to manage the site.

Thank you in advance for your understanding - you will not need to adjust anything at your end as the payments are processed under the existing Direct Debit arrangement.
